Eligibility

These services are provided automatically to all enrolled, registered students of San Diego State University. This excludes extension and open university students and English as a second language students.

Student Health Services

In order to be seen by a medical provider or have a vision exam, you must make an appointment in advance. Any appointment that you cannot keep must be cancelled. As soon as you have an appointment, please go to Student Health Services located in the Administration building, office 104D and request a health service referral. Without this referral, you will be responsible for payment for your office visit.

The health services program covers the following basic services:

Basic Services:

- Illness and basic healthcare
- Limited clinical laboratory
- Gynecological examination
- Vision examination
- Immunizations (MMR, HepB & TB)
- Counseling services

Measles-Rubella

Immunization Requirement

All new and re-admitted students born on or after January 1, 1957 are required to show proof of immunity to both measles and rubella. Students must fulfill this requirement during their first semester at SDSU, or an Immunization hold will be placed on their registration for the second semester of classes. To avoid this hold, please provide proof of immunity. If you do not have proof of your immunity you need to get vaccinated. Please stop by Student Health Services and request a referral to receive your vaccination at the Imperial County Health Department.

CPR
